

National Survey of 1000 Likely Voters  
Conducted May 17-18, 2017  
By Pulse Opinion Research

1\* For years, there were laws protecting the American flag. In 1989, by a 5-4 vote, the Supreme Court said that those laws violate the First Amendment. Should laws against burning or urinating on the flag be allowed?

44% Yes  
48% No  
9% Not sure

2\* Should burning or urinating on the American flag, or other forms of its physical desecration, be protected under the First Amendment to the Constitution?

51% Yes  
40% No  
10% Not sure

3\* Do you support or oppose a new amendment to the Constitution that would restore the power of Congress to protect the American flag from physical desecration?

56% Support  
30% Oppose  
13% Not sure

4\* An amendment becomes part of the Constitution by a vote of the states. However, Congress must first agree to send it to the states for a vote. Should Congress send the flag amendment to the states for a vote?

57% Yes  
34% No  
9% Not sure

5\* How likely would you be to vote for a Senator or Representative who refused to let people in the states vote on an amendment to the Constitution that would prevent physical desecration of the American flag?

18% Very likely  
15% Somewhat likely  
19% Somewhat unlikely  
25% Very unlikely  
22% Not sure
