4* An amendment becomes part of the Constitution by a vote of the states. However, Congress must first agree to send it to the states for a vote. Should Congress send the flag amendment to the states for a vote?

5* How likely would you be to vote for a Senator or Representative who refused to let people in the states vote on an amendment to the Constitution that would prevent physical desecration of the American flag?
