

DOWNTOWN INDY CIRCLE CENTRE MALL'S REDEVELOPMENT BEGINS

The transformation of Circle Centre Mall is officially in motion, with Hendricks Commercial Properties starting the **\$600 million redevelopment** of this 2.5-block downtown Indianapolis mainstay.

Please see below for construction updates regarding Downtown Indy:

- Beginning **April 7**, the south inside portion of Circle Centre Mall (bordered by Illinois and Meridian Streets and Maryland and Georgia Streets) will close for construction, including **removing the skywalk** from the Omni Severin Hotel into the mall.
- The skywalk from the World of Wonders parking garage over Illinois Street into the mall will be **temporarily closed**.
- The mall's main concourse and food court will **remain open**.
- All parking will **remain open**.

The project will be completed in two phases, with this first phase set to finish by 2030.

When complete, the project will take on a new name and include 400,000 square feet of retail and entertainment space, 100,000 square feet of office space, 300 residential units, and 100,000 square feet of outdoor public space. Parking will all remain in place.
