Dear Junior Cadet Applicant:

Congratulations on being selected for the Ohio State Highway Patrol 2016 Junior Cadet Program. You are to report to the Training Academy, 740 East 17th Avenue, Columbus, Ohio, on Sunday, June 26, 2016, at 7:00 p.m. Please arrive dressed in business casual attire; blue jeans are not an option. You will need to bring the following items:

1. One pair black leather casual shoes (normal/low heel height)
2. Gym clothes (black/dark blue shorts). Shorts should be knee-length
3. One pair exercise/running shoes
4. One swimsuit (females, 1 piece conservative)
5. Necessary underclothing, toilet articles, bathrobe (full length) and shower shoes
6. Five pairs white and black, athletic style socks, no ankle socks
7. Three plain grey T-shirts (Haines or Fruit of the Loom)
8. Black compression shorts
9. One pair long black wind pants or jogging pants
10. Dark slacks / trousers and one black belt (one inch)
11. Alarm clock (not cell phone)

While at the Academy, Junior Cadets will wear dark dress slacks, black socks, and black shoes. You will be given shirts when you arrive on Sunday to wear throughout the week. As physical fitness will be a part of the daily activities, Junior Cadets need to bring enough clothes for the entire week (day/evening activities). The Academy will furnish towels, linens, and all meals.

Portable electronics (laptops, tablets, or handheld games) are not permitted. In addition, no tobacco products are permitted on the Academy premises. Junior Cadets will be allowed to use their cell phones to contact family during designated evening hours.

Parents and friends are welcome to attend the Junior Cadet Graduation, which will be held at 1:00 p.m. on Thursday, June 30, 2016. Junior Cadets will be released immediately following the graduation.

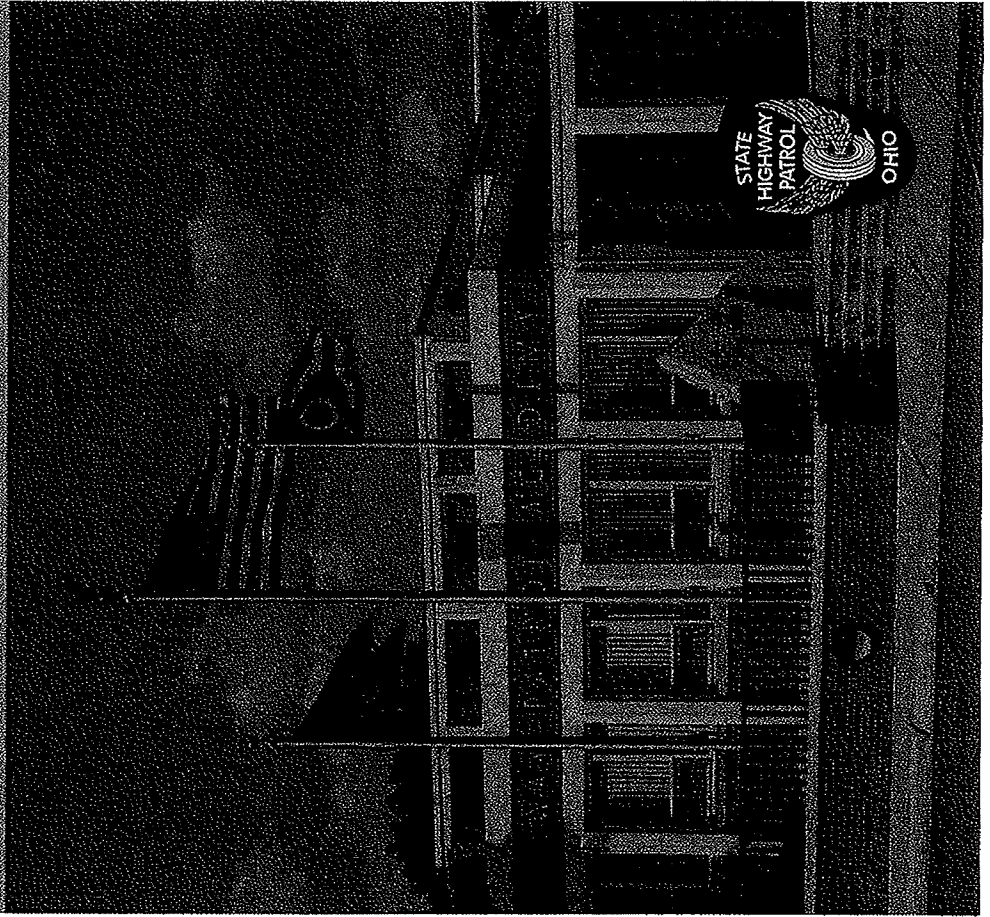

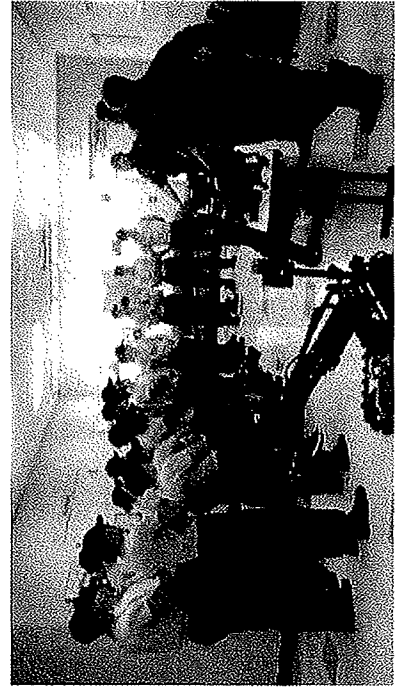
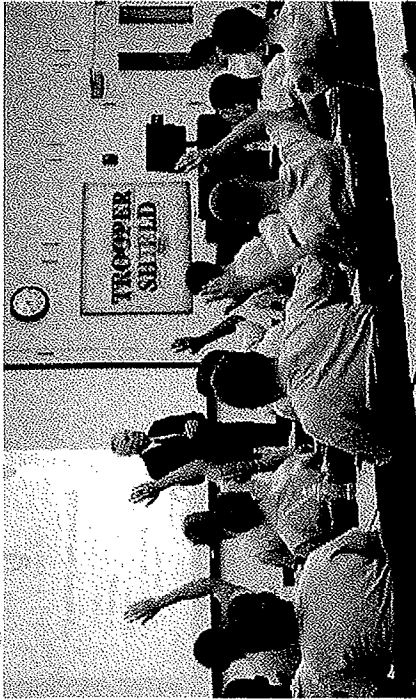

Local resident graduates from Highway Patrol Junior Cadet Program

COLUMBUS – *A local resident* completed training today for the Ohio State Highway Patrol’s Junior Cadet Program held June 26-30, 2016 at the Highway Patrol Training Academy in Columbus. *A local resident* was one of 40 Junior Cadet participants selected from applications submitted by young men and women who attended Buckeye Boys and Girls State earlier this month, exhibited exemplary performance throughout the previous school year, or eligible children of Patrol employees who will be high school seniors this year.

The Junior Cadet Program is designed to give young people better insight into the challenges faced by law enforcement officers by enabling them to experience a typical week at the Training Academy. To enhance their learning experience, Junior Cadets are required to stay at the Training Academy, sleeping in the dormitories and dining in the cafeteria. While at the Academy, they gain knowledge from Patrol Academy staff regarding crash investigation, officer/violator contacts, self-defense tactics, K-9 operations, emergency vehicle operations, motorcycle operations, impaired driver apprehension and military drill.

Lt. Colonel George W. Williams, Superintendent, presented graduation certificates to the young men and women who participated in the Junior Cadet Program at a ceremony held today at the Training Academy. Family and friends of the cadets were also in attendance.
